PUBLIC NOTICE RE:
GREEN MOUNTAIN POWER CORPORATION'S
PROPOSED SUBSTATION UPGRADE IN BARRE, VERMONT

You are hereby notified that Green Mountain Power Corporation (“GMP”) has filed a petition with the Vermont Public Service Board (“Board”) for a certificate of public good (“CPG”), pursuant to 30 V.S.A. Section 248(j), authorizing upgrades of the GMP Barre North End substation located on Railroad Street in Barre, Vermont.

The proposed upgrades consist of the removal and replacement of all equipment and steel structures at the GMP substation, and the installation of new fence with foundations and yard lighting. More detailed information is available in the petition, copies of which are available for review at the Public Service Board's offices at 112 State Street, 4th Floor, People's United Bank Building, Montpelier, Vermont, and at the City of Barre City Clerk's Office, 6 North Main Street, Barre, Vermont. Persons wishing to submit comments as to whether the petition raises a significant issue with respect to the substantive criteria of 30 V.S.A. If no comments raising substantive issues are received, the Board may grant a CPG without a hearing.
