**I. INTRODUCTION**

This case involves an application filed by the University of Vermont ("Applicant") on July 15, 2010, requesting a certificate of public good ("CPG") pursuant to 30 V.S.A. §§ 219a and 248 and Vermont Public Service Board ("Board") Rule 5.100, for a net metering system. The project consists of 17 pole-mounted photovoltaic arrays on the Applicant's property in South Burlington, Vermont.

Notice of the application has been sent to all parties as specified in the Board's Rule 5.100. The notice stated that any party wishing to submit comments or request a hearing in this matter needed to file comments with the Board within thirty (30) working days of the date that the notice of the application was sent.

On July 15, 2010, Eric and Susan Ayers, adjoining landowners, filed comments and requested a hearing before the Board.

On August 30, 2010, AllEarth Renewables, Inc. ("AllEarth"), the installer of the proposed system, filed comments in response to the Ayers' letter.

No comments have been received from any other parties or interested persons.

The Board has reviewed the application and accompanying documents and concludes that, pursuant to 30 V.S.A. §§ 219a and 248 and the Board's Rule 5.100, a CPG should be issued without further investigation or hearing.
