WAIVER OF STATUTORY NOTICE PURSUANT TO 30 V.S.A. §248(f)

The Rutland Town Planning Commission, having received notice – including construction plans – on March 19, 2009, of a proposal to construct a 50 kW solar array and educational display on U.S. Route 7, finds that in the opinion of the Commission:

1. The project will not affect the orderly development of the region;
2. The project will not affect any land conservation measures in the Rutland Town Plan;
3. The project does not raise a significant issue with respect to the substantive criteria of 30 V.S.A. §248(b);
4. The Commission does not recommend any changes to the project design as proposed by Central Vermont Public Service Corp. (CVPS) on the above-referenced plans.

Therefore, pursuant to 30 V.S.A. §248(f), the Commission hereby waives its right to 45 days notice prior to the filing of a petition for a Certificate of Public Good by CVPS. Should the Vermont Public Service Board (the "Board") decide to hold one or more public hearings before ruling on such a petition, the Commission reserves the right to participate to the fullest extent allowed under Board rules.
