**CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC GOOD ISSUED**  
**PURSUANT TO 30 V.S.A. SECTION 248**

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the Public Service Board of the State of Vermont this day found and adjudged that the reconstruction of the Village of Enosburg Falls Water and Light Department, Inc.'s ("Enosburg") Main Village Substation facilities and related line improvements, will promote the general good of the State, subject to the following conditions:

1. Construction, operation and maintenance of the project shall be in accordance with the plans and evidence submitted in this proceeding.
2. Enosburg shall obtain and comply with all conditions and requirements of all necessary permits and approvals.
3. Prior to commencement of construction on the project, Enosburg shall file and obtain Board approval of a detailed statement identifying the chosen configuration and describing the justification for the choice of that configuration.
4. Prior to purchasing a new transformer for the project, Enosburg shall file and obtain Board approval of an analysis demonstrating that the chosen transformer is the least-cost option under the societal test.
5. Within 30 days of the date on which construction of the Proposed Project is completed, Enosburg shall review the Proposed Project with the Board's staff, the Department of Public Service and the Agency of Natural Resources to determine whether plantings and landscaping will be necessary to address visual impacts of the Proposed Project. If the Board determines that any

plantings and landscaping are necessary, Enosburg shall prepare and submit, within 60 days of the review, the necessary plans to the Board for approval. All plantings and landscaping shall be completed within one year of Board approval.

6. Enosburg shall:

(a) Use appropriate practices for erosion control and site management, consistent with the Vermont Handbook for Soil Erosion and Sediment Control on Construction Sites available from ANR;

(b) Seed disturbed areas following construction activity for the annual grass to allow for the return of native vegetation to the site;

(c) Not engage in significant clearing of large vegetation, such as trees; and

(d) Prior to the commencement of construction, file a detailed site-specific erosion control plan for Board review and approval.

7. This certificate shall not be transferred without prior approval of the Board.
