CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC GOOD ISSUED
PURSUANT TO 30 V.S.A. SECTION 248

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the Public Service Board of the State of Vermont this day found and adjudged that the installation, for up to five years, by enXco (East Coast), Inc. ("enXco") of two temporary wind measurement towers on Lowell Mountain in Lowell, Vermont, will promote the general good of the State, subject to the following conditions:

1. Construction, operation and maintenance of the facility shall be in accordance with the plans and evidence submitted in this proceeding.
2. The wind measurement towers approved herein shall be unpainted and left in their natural weathered galvanized color.
3. A certificate of public good shall be obtained from this Board prior to the construction of any wind turbines or associated improvements at this site.
4. enXco shall minimize tree cutting in connection with the approved project and shall work with a professional forester, prior to cutting any trees, to determine which trees to cut.
5. enXco shall not use herbicides in connection with the approved project.
6. This Certificate shall not be transferred without prior approval of the Board.
7. All components of the wind measurement towers shall be removed from the site within five years from the date of this Order.
