**CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC GOOD ISSUED**  
**PURSUANT TO 30 V.S.A. SECTION 248**

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the Public Service Board of the State of Vermont this day found and adjudged that the reconstruction of 1.5 miles of 34.5 kV transmission line within an existing transmission corridor, the addition of circuit breakers at three existing substations, the addition of a new 18 ft. x 24 ft. building at each of two existing substations, and the addition of one new motor-operated disconnect switch at an existing substation, all located within the Town of St. Albans, Vermont, will promote the general good of the state, subject to the following conditions:

1. Construction, operation and maintenance of the project shall be in accordance with the plans and evidence submitted in this proceeding.
2. Central Vermont Public Service Corporation shall obtain and comply with all conditions and requirements of all necessary permits and approvals.
3. Within thirty (30) days after the completion of construction, Central Vermont Public Service Corporation, the Board's staff, and representatives of the St. Albans Town Selectboard and Planning Commission shall conduct a site visit of the Nason Street Substation to review the landscaping plan. Within thirty (30) days of the site visit, the resulting landscaping plan shall be

submitted to the Board for it's review and approval. All screen planting shall be completed within one (1) year of the Board's approval.

4. This Certificate shall not be transferred without prior approval of the Board.
