CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC GOOD ISSUED
PURSUANT TO 30 V.S.A. SECTION 248

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the Public Service Board of the State of Vermont this day found and adjudged that the installation of a phase angle regulator and related equipment at VELCO's Sand Bar substation in Milton, Vermont will promote the general good of the state, subject to the following conditions:

1. Construction, operation, and maintenance of the project shall be in accordance with the plans and evidence submitted in this proceeding.
2. VELCO shall obtain and comply with all conditions and requirements of all necessary permits and approvals.
3. The Stipulation filed by the parties on July 23, 2003 (Joint Exhibit 1) is accepted and approved. Compliance with all terms of the Stipulation, except as modified herein, is required.
4. The wastewater disposal facilities are specifically not approved in this Certificate of Public Good. Prior to construction of said facilities, VELCO shall file a request with the Board to modify the Certificate of Public Good to authorize such construction; VELCO's request shall include specific evidence that the facility will meet all applicable DEC regulations. This Docket shall remain open in order to review this request.

5. The Board has continuing jurisdiction to resolve any disputes arising under the above-mentioned Stipulation.

6. This Certificate of Public Good shall not be transferred without prior approval of the Board.
