ORDER RE AARP MOTION TO INTERVENE

On October 7, 2003, the American Association for Retired Persons ("AARP") filed a motion to intervene in this Docket. In its motion, AARP asks that it be allowed to intervene as of right, pursuant to Board Rule 2.209(A), and in the alternative asks that it be granted permissive intervention pursuant to Board Rule 2.209(B).

On October 16, 2003, Central Vermont Public Service Corporation ("CVPS") filed a response, stating that it did not object to granting permissive intervention to AARP.

We grant AARP permissive intervention, under Board Rule 2.209(B).¹

1. There is no need to rule on AARP's request to intervene as of right, given that we have granted it permissive intervention.
