CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC GOOD ISSUED
PURSUANT TO 30 V.S.A. SECTION 248

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the Public Service Board of the State of Vermont this day found and adjudged that the reconstruction and enclosure by Vermont Gas Systems, Inc. ("VGS") of an existing pressure-regulation station ("Station" or "Project") on Lake Road in St. Albans, Vermont, will promote the general good of the state, subject to the following conditions:

1. Construction, operation and maintenance of the Project shall be in accordance with the plans and evidence submitted in this proceeding.
2. VGS shall obtain and comply with all conditions and requirements of all necessary permits and approvals.
3. VGS shall promptly remove all fire hazards surrounding the existing pressure-regulation station and shall develop, in consultation with the Vermont Department of Public Service, a layout for the proposed Station that gives due consideration to the importance of maintaining a non-combustible materials buffer around ignition sources.
4. This Certificate shall not be transferred without prior approval of the Board.
