IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the Public Service Board of the State of Vermont this day found and adjudged that the proposed relocation by Central Vermont Public Service Corporation of approximately 600 feet of 46 kV transmission lines to accommodate construction at Rutland City Wastewater Treatment Facility in Rutland, Vermont, in accordance with the evidence and plans submitted in this proceeding, will promote the general good of the State, subject to the following conditions:

1. Construction, operation, and maintenance of the project shall be in accordance with the plans and evidence submitted in this proceeding.
2. This Certificate of Public Good shall not be transferred without prior approval of the Board.
3. CVPS shall file a plan, outlining methods for controlling honeysuckle in the VICON corridor, by December 31, 2004.
