PURSUANT TO 30 V.S.A. SECTION 248**

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the Public Service Board of the State of Vermont this day found and adjudged that the proposed construction of three wireless communication antennas and associated equipment on, and adjacent to, Green Mountain Power Corporation ("GMP")'s transmission structure number 89 in Richmond, Vermont, in accordance with the evidence and plans submitted in this proceeding, will promote the general good of the State, subject to the following conditions:

1. Construction, operation, and maintenance of the project shall be in accordance with the plans and evidence submitted in this proceeding.
2. The installation and maintenance of Independent Wireless One Leased Realty Corporation's facilities on GMP's transmission tower must be performed by, or under the direct supervision of, GMP.
3. The use of barbed wire is not approved at this location. IWO may, at its option, construct either a six-foot chain link fence screened by green "easy fencing" (as proposed in this proceeding, but without the barbed wire) or an eight-foot wooden stockade fence (as approved by this Board in Docket 6978).
4. This Certificate of Public Good shall not be transferred without prior approval of the Board.
