CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC GOOD ISSUED
PURSUANT TO 30 V.S.A. SECTION 248

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the Public Service Board of the State of Vermont this day found and adjudged that Central Vermont Public Service Corporation's ("CVPS") proposed reconstruction and expansion of the Bethel substation in Royalton, Vermont, and the year-2000 replacement of the 5 MVA transformer at the Bethel substation with a 10 MVA transformer, in accordance with the evidence and plans submitted in this proceeding, will promote the general good of the State, subject to the following conditions:

1. Construction, operation, and maintenance of the project shall be in accordance with the plans and evidence submitted in this proceeding.
2. Within two months of the completion of construction, CVPS shall file a post-construction landscaping plan for approval by the Board. This plan shall include all of the planting and other landscaping or aesthetic mitigation proposals for the entire post-construction project. In addition to filing this plan with the Board and parties to this Docket, CVPS shall also submit this plan to the adjoining landowners and the Royalton Planning Commission. Any comments on the post-construction landscaping plan shall be due at the Board two weeks after CVPS files the plan. When submitting the plan to the adjoining landowners and the Royalton Planning Commission, CVPS shall inform them of the comment deadline and the address to which to send any comments. Based upon the landscaping plan and any comments received, the Board may schedule a post-construction site visit, and may require additional aesthetic mitigation.
3. This Certificate of Public Good shall not be transferred without prior approval of the Board.
