**CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC GOOD ISSUED**  
**PURSUANT TO 30 V.S.A. SECTION 248**

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the Public Service Board of the State of Vermont this day found and adjudged that the proposed upgrades at Waterbury Center Substation #47, located on Route 100 north of Waterbury, Vermont, by Green Mountain Power Corporation ("GMP"), in accordance with the evidence and plans submitted in this proceeding, will promote the general good of the State, subject to the following conditions:

1. Construction, operation, and maintenance of the project shall be in accordance with the plans and evidence submitted in this proceeding.
2. Within two months of the completion of construction, GMP shall file a post-construction landscaping plan for approval by the Board. This plan shall include all of the planting and other landscaping and aesthetic mitigation proposals for the entire post-construction project. In addition to filing this plan with the Board and parties to this Docket, GMP shall also submit this plan to the adjoining landowners and the Waterbury Planning Commission. Any comments on the post-construction landscaping plan shall be due at the Board two weeks after GMP files the plan. When submitting the plan to the adjoining landowners and Planning Commission, GMP shall inform them of the comment deadline and the address to which to send any comments. Based upon the landscaping plan and any comments received, the Board may schedule a post-construction site visit, and may require additional aesthetic mitigation.
3. GMP shall not commence construction prior to receiving a determination from the Agency of Natural Resources ("ANR") as to whether an amendment to the Conditional Use Determination that GMP originally received for this project is required. GMP shall provide the Board and Department of Public Service with a copy of the notification it receives from ANR.

4. This Certificate of Public Good shall not be transferred without prior approval of the Board.
