IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the Public Service Board of the State of Vermont this day found and adjudged that the proposed construction of a methane-fueled electric generating facility at the Gervais Family Farm in Bakersfield, Vermont, in accordance with the evidence and plans submitted in this proceeding, will promote the general good of the State, subject to the following conditions:

1. Construction, operation, and maintenance of the project shall be in accordance with the plans and evidence submitted in this proceeding.
2. All recommendations of the System Impact Study filed on April 2, 2007, must be followed.
3. The Gervais Family Farm shall not utilize manure from other farms as fuel for the generation system, absent approval from the Public Service Board.
4. This Certificate of Public Good shall not be transferred without prior approval of the Board.
