CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC GOOD
ISSUED PURSUANT TO 30 V.S.A. SECTION 231

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the Public Service Board of the State of Vermont ("Board") on this day finds and adjudges that the issuance of a certificate of public good ("CPG") to Startec Global Operating Company ("Startec Global"), and the provision of telecommunications services by Startec Global, will promote the general good of the State of Vermont, subject to the following conditions:

1. Startec Global is subject to the provisions of Title 30, Vermont Statutes Annotated, to the same extent as other regulated utilities.
2. Startec Global shall terminate all telecommunications traffic routed to its customers by any telecommunications carrier with which Startec Global interconnects.
3. Startec Global may participate in any Board investigation into local competition and/or competitive access services. Startec Global shall be bound to comply with any lawful requirement imposed by the Board governing the obligations of telecommunications carriers in Vermont.
4. Startec Global's books, accounts, statements, and other financial records shall, in accordance with Vermont law, be made available for examination by the Board or the Vermont Department of Public Service.
5. This CPG may not be transferred to any other party without prior approval by the Board.
6. Startec Global intends to conduct business in the State of Vermont under the name Startec Global Operating Company, and has filed appropriate documents with the Secretary of State. If Startec Global intends to do business in the State of Vermont under a name other than the name in use on the date of this Order, it shall file a notice of the new trade name with the

Clerk of the Board and the Vermont Department of Public Service at least 15 days prior to commencing business under the new trade name.¹

7. If Startec Global at any time in the future proposes to offer operator services, it shall be required to comply with Board Rule 7.609(G).

8. If Startec Global at any time in the future proposes to offer prepaid calling card services, it shall post a bond, payable to the Board, in an amount equivalent to its projected intrastate revenues from its prepaid calling card service for the first twelve (12) months of operation.

9. Startec Global shall be subject to any rules lawfully adopted or to be adopted by the Board, and its CPG hereby incorporates those rules by reference. Startec Global's CPG shall be subject to revocation upon good cause, including a substantial or continuous failure to abide by its material terms.
