CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC GOOD ISSUED
PURSUANT TO 30 V.S.A. SECTION 248

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the Public Service Board of the State of Vermont this day found and adjudged that the proposed replacement of transformers and associated bus work at the Bellows Falls Station, in Bellows Falls, Vermont, by TransCanada Hydro Northeast, Inc. ("TC Hydro"), in accordance with the evidence and plans submitted in this proceeding, will promote the general good of the State, subject to the following conditions:

1. Construction, operation, and maintenance of the project shall be in accordance with the plans and evidence submitted in this proceeding.
2. TC Hydro may not energize the project unless New England Power Company, d/b/a National Grid, submits to the Public Service Board ("Board") a proposal for removing the existing transformers, and receives Board approval for that proposal.
3. TC Hydro may not remove the 6.6 kV feed to the Green Mountain Power Corporation ("GMP") Bridge Street substation unless the Board approves GMP's petition in Docket No. 7382 to reconstruct that substation, and until the 6.6 kV feed is no longer needed to provide power to that substation.
4. TC Hydro must file proposed final design plans for the oil containment system, including maintenance and inspection schedules and procedures, prior to construction of the oil containment system.
5. This Certificate of Public Good shall not be transferred without prior approval of the Board.
