CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC GOOD ISSUED
PURSUANT TO 30 V.S.A. SECTION 248

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the Public Service Board of the State of Vermont this day found and adjudged that the proposed construction of a 3.2 MW landfill gas-to-energy facility and associated transmission infrastructure, in Moretown, Vermont, by PPL Renewable Energy, LLC ("PPL") and Green Mountain Power Corporation ("GMP"), in accordance with the evidence and plans submitted in this proceeding, will promote the general good of the State, subject to the following conditions:

1. Construction, operation, and maintenance of the project shall be in accordance with the plans and evidence submitted in this proceeding.
2. The Memorandum of Understanding and Stipulation filed by the parties on July 3, 2008, is accepted and approved. Petitioners must comply with all terms of the Memorandum of Understanding and Stipulation.
3. PPL must obtain an air quality permit and comply with any conditions that the permit might contain.
4. PPL must file its air quality permit with the Board, upon receipt.
5. In the event that PPL's air quality permit application is denied, PPL must notify the Board within 24 hours after receiving such denial.
6. GMP must file its tree-cutting plan and revised tree-cutting plan, if applicable, with the Board, upon its approval by the Agency of Natural Resources.

7. Site preparation, construction of PPL's generation facility, and construction of GMP's interconnection facilities may commence prior to the issuance and filing of an air quality permit; however, PPL may not commence operation of the generation facility prior to the issuance of an air quality permit and the filing of the permit with the Board.

8. All construction activities will be in compliance with ANR's Low Risk Site Handbook for Soil Erosion Prevention and Sediment Control.

9. This Certificate of Public Good shall not be transferred without prior approval of the Board.
