**CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC GOOD ISSUED**  
**PURSUANT TO 30 V.S.A. SECTION 248**

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the Public Service Board of the State of Vermont this day found and adjudged that Central Vermont Public Service Corporation's ("CVPS") reconstruction of an electrical substation on Walnut Street in Brandon, Vermont, including the replacement of an existing 3 MVA transformer with an existing 3.75 MVA transformer and the replacement of the 3.75 MVA transformer with a new 5 MVA transformer, in accordance with the evidence and plans submitted in this proceeding (the "Project"), will promote the general good of the State, subject to the following conditions:

1. Construction, operation, and maintenance of the project shall be in accordance with the plans and evidence submitted in this proceeding. Upon completion of the Project, CVPS shall file "as-built" plans for the Project.
2. Prior to commencement of site preparation for and construction of the Project, CVPS shall file with the Public Service Board ("Board") confirmation that it has obtained all required permits and copies of the same shall have been filed with the Board.
3. CVPS shall plant one blue spruce tree along the west end of the new control building. CVPS and the Department of Public Service shall review the Project upon completion for exact placement of all trees and shall submit a proposed design to the Board for approval. Once placement of the trees is determined and approved by the Board, CVPS shall act expeditiously to have such trees planted.
4. The row of cedar trees to be planted on the south side of the substation as a replacement for the existing trees shall consist of trees at least six feet in height planted no more than six feet apart.

5. The Board will retain jurisdiction to review and approve post-construction aesthetic mitigation measures.

6. This Certificate of Public Good shall not be transferred without prior approval of the Board.
