CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC GOOD ISSUED
PURSUANT TO 30 V.S.A. SECTION 248

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the Public Service Board of the State of Vermont this day found and adjudged that the construction by Vermont Gas Systems, Inc., of approximately 700 feet of a 10-inch-diameter, natural-gas pipeline in Colchester, Vermont, in accordance with the evidence and plans submitted in this proceeding, will promote the general good of the State, subject to the following conditions:

1. Construction, operation and maintenance of the project shall be in accordance with the plans and evidence submitted in this proceeding.
2. Construction within the stream bed shall be limited to periods of no flow or minimal flow; the work area shall be isolated from stream flow; the disturbed areas shall be stabilized against erosion prior to completion of the project; the equipment used for the construction shall be clean and well maintained, free of gear, oil and hydraulic leaks.
3. If construction of the project is undertaken between October 15 and April 15, then Vermont Gas Systems, Inc., shall comply with the construction requirements contained in the Vermont Department of Environmental Conservation's Low Risk Site Handbook for Erosion Prevention and Sediment Control.
4. This Certificate of Public Good shall not be transferred without prior approval of the Board.
