**CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC GOOD ISSUED**  
**PURSUANT TO 30 V.S.A. SECTION 248**

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the Public Service Board of the State of Vermont ("Board") this day found and adjudged that the two temporary meteorological towers proposed by the Foundation for a Sustainable Future to be located at 410 Camel's Hump Road in Huntington, Vermont, will promote the general good of the State, subject to the following conditions:

1. Construction, operation and maintenance of the project shall be in accordance with the plans and evidence submitted in this proceeding. Any material or substantial change in the project is prohibited without prior Board approval.
2. The net metering system shall comply with applicable existing and future statutory requirements and Board Rules and Orders.
3. Both wind measurement towers and associated equipment shall be removed within three months of the date of this Certificate of Public Good. .
4. In the event this Certificate is transferred pursuant to Board Rule 5.100, Section 5.107(B)1, the new owner of the system must file the required certificate transfer form with the Board prior to commencing operation of the system.
