IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the Public Service Board of the State of Vermont this day found and adjudged that the construction of a multi-fuel peaking generation unit and related electric generation facilities by the Vermont Public Power Supply Authority ("VPPSA") and the Swanton Village, Inc. Electric Department ("SED") (collectively, the "Petitioners"), in Swanton, Vermont, in accordance with the evidence and plans submitted in this proceeding (the "Project"), will promote the general good of the State, subject to the following conditions:

1. Construction, operation, and maintenance of the Project shall be in accordance with the plans and evidence submitted in this proceeding. Upon completion of the Project, the Petitioners shall file "as-built" plans for the Project.
2. Prior to commencement of site preparation for and construction of the Project, the Petitioners shall file with the Public Service Board ("Board") confirmation that it has obtained all required permits and copies of the same shall have been filed with the Board.
3. The Petitioners shall comply with all conditions and recommendation contained in the Independent System Operator of New England System Impact Study.
4. This Certificate of Public Good shall not be transferred without prior approval of the Board.
