IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the Public Service Board of the State of Vermont ("Board") this day found and adjudged that the temporary meteorological tower proposed by Central Vermont Public Service Corporation to be located at 2152 Post Road in Rutland, Vermont, will promote the general good of the State, subject to the following conditions:

1. Construction, operation and maintenance of the project shall be in accordance with the plans and evidence submitted in this proceeding. Any material or substantial change in the project is prohibited without prior Board approval.

2. The project shall comply with applicable existing and future statutory requirements and Board Rules and Orders.

3. The temporary wind measurement tower and associated equipment shall be removed within three years following its installation.

4. In the event this Certificate is transferred pursuant to Board Rule 5.100, Section 5.109(C)1, the new owner must file the required certificate transfer form with the Board prior to commencing operation.
