**ORDER CLOSING DOCKET**

REPORT

On June 6, 1997, LCI International Telecom Corp. ("LCI") filed a petition seeking authority to amend its Certificate of Public Good ("CPG") to authorize LCI to provide local exchange service. The parties agreed to a schedule by which the applicant and the Department of Public Service would submit a joint draft Proposal for Decision for review and approval. After a prolonged period of inactivity, on May 5, 1999, I sent a letter to LCI requesting the Company to affirm its continued intention to seek a CPG and to state the date by which a draft Proposal for Decision could be expected.

On June 8, 1999, LCI responded stating that LCI wanted to withdraw the application without prejudice for potential refiling. LCI's withdrawal will make this proceeding moot.

I recommend that the Board allow LCI to withdraw its petition and close this Docket.

The foregoing is hereby reported to the Public Service Board in accordance with the provisions of 30 V.S.A. § 8.

As this Proposal for Decision is not adverse to any party, I have not circulated it for comments.<sup>1</sup>
