AMENDED CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC GOOD
ISSUED PURSUANT TO 30 V.S.A. § 231

On January 21, 1985, the Public Service Board ("Board") issued Sunshine Water Company, Inc. ("Sunshine" or the "Company") a Certificate of Public Good ("CPG") to operate certain small water systems in the Rutland, Vermont area. See Docket No. 4919, Order of 1/21/85.

On this date, the Board has found that the abandonment of Sunshine's Countryside Estates Water System will promote the general good of the State of Vermont, and has issued an Order approving the abandonment of the system.

WHEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the Certificate of Public Good that was granted to Sunshine Water Company, Inc. on January 21, 1985, is amended to delete reference to the Countryside Estates Water System, as of the date of the Order approving the abandonment of the system.
