CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC GOOD ISSUED
PURSUANT TO 30 V.S.A. SECTION 231

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the Public Service Board of the State of Vermont on this date finds and adjudges that the operation of telecommunications services within Vermont by WinStar Wireless, Inc. ("the Company") will promote the general good of the State of Vermont, subject to the following conditions:

1. The Company is subject to the provisions of Title 30, V.S.A., to the same extent as other toll providers.

2. If the Company at any time in the future proposes to offer operator services, it shall be required to comply with the results of Docket No. 5566, Generic Investigation into the Regulation of Public Telephone and Alternative Operator Services in Vermont.

3. The Company is doing business within the State of Vermont under the name WinStar Wireless, Inc. If the Company intends to do business in the State of Vermont under a name that differs from the name in use on the date of the Order in this Docket, it shall file a notice of the new trade name with the Clerk of the Board and the Department of Public Service at least fifteen (15) days before commencing business under the new trade name.¹

4. This Certificate may not be transferred to any other party without prior approval by the Public Service Board.

5. The Company shall be subject to any rules lawfully adopted or to be adopted by the Board, and its Certificate of Public Good shall incorporate those rules by reference. The

Company's Certificate shall be subject to revocation upon good cause, including a substantial or continuous failure to abide by its material terms.
