**REPORT**

The Public Service Board initiated this investigation on November 3, 1998, to examine issues raised by an amendment to the Special Contract between New England Telephone and Telegraph Company d/b/a Bell Atlantic-Vermont ("Bell Atlantic" or "Company") and the City of Burlington.<sup>1</sup> By letter dated November 16, 1998, Bell Atlantic withdrew its request for approval of the contract amendment, stating that the Company expected to negotiate further amendments and submit those for approval. No party opposed Bell Atlantic's withdrawal of the request for approval.

The withdrawal of the amendment renders this proceeding moot. I, therefore, recommend that the Board close this docket.

Because this recommendation is not adverse to any party, it has not been circulated for comment.<sup>2</sup>
