PREHEARING CONFERENCE MEMORANDUM

BACKGROUND

On October 12, 1999, I convened a prehearing conference in this proceeding. Appearances were entered by: Aaron Adler, Esq., and Tom Franks, for the Vermont Department of Public Service ("Department"); Jules Junker for the State Office of Economic Opportunity ("SOEO"); and Charles Underhill, Greg Needle, and Trevor Lewis, Esq., of Primmer & Piper, PC, for the Vermont Public Power Supply Authority, ("VPPSA") on behalf of Barton Village, Inc. Electric Department, Village of Enosburg Falls Water & Light Department, Town of Hardwick Electric Department, Village of Hyde Park Electric Department, Village of Northfield Electric Department and Swanton Village, Inc. Electric Department.

SCHEDULE

None of the prehearing conference participants sought evidentiary hearings on VPPSA's request for approval of a fuel gross receipts tax credit pursuant to 33 V.S.A. § 2503. Instead, the petitioner and the Department will attempt to resolve this proceeding through negotiations, with the expectation that the Department's concerns can be addressed through conditions incorporated into a jointly stipulated agreement. To this end, petitioner and the Department agreed that they would attempt to submit a joint stipulation to the Hearing Officer by November 1, 1999.

Accordingly , I will not set a schedule at this time. If the parties cannot reach agreement through negotiation, they will inform me and I will convene a status conference to schedule further proceedings.
