**PREHEARING CONFERENCE MEMORANDUM**

I convened a prehearing conference in this matter on June 6, 2000. Washington Electric Cooperative, Inc. ("WEC") was represented by Joshua Diamond, Esq., of Diamond & Associates, P.C.; John Cotter, Esq., appeared on behalf of the Vermont Department of Public Service ("Department"). No other person or organization attended the prehearing conference.

At the prehearing conference, the parties informed me that they had reached an agreement in principle regarding the implementation of WEC's proposed reduction to the monthly water heater timer credit. They anticipate filing a Memorandum of Understanding and a draft proposal for decision by June 14, 2000. At the hearing, I agreed to this schedule.

In addition, at the prehearing conference I established June 16, 2000, as the deadline to file requests for intervention. Parties shall have until June 23, 2000, to respond to any such requests. All such requests and responses must be served on all parties.
