SUMMARY OF PUBLIC COMMENTS AT PUBLIC HEARING | JUNE 20, 2019 PETITION OF OTTER CREEK SOLAR (WARNER SOLAR PROJECT) PUC Case No. 19-0516-PET

At the public hearing held on June 20, 2019 in Bennington Vermont, several members of the public raised the following issues:

- 1. Potential impact on local businesses as a result of the views of the proposed project.
- 2. The proposed project does not qualify as "preferred site" under the Town Plan.
- 3. Removal of trees for the project will result in less carbon capture.
- 4. Birds that populate the area will be adversely affected by removal of the trees.
- 5. Noise from construction will adversely impact nearby businesses that rely on tourist business.
- 6. The use of sheep to control grass on the site may create adverse noise.
- 7. Will there be an adequate recourse if the project owner fails to meet permit conditions?
- 8. Concerns were raised about the possibility that persons who oppose the project may be sued by the project developers.
- 9. Consideration should be given to the words of the Town Plan and not just to the statements made by Town officials.
- 10. The project may have an adverse effect on the value of adjacent properties.
- 11. The existence of many solar projects in Bennington needs to be considered and not just this one project in assessing the visual and grand list impacts.
- 12. Will the actual appearance of the project be able to be accurately depicted by simulations including views from both nearby and distant locations?
